

- Become more approachable

- Become more proficient with technology

Pareto Principle

• Sherman applies the Pareto Principle as

20% of the actions, inputs, and efforts lead to the majority of results, outputs or rewards

• Upon identifying the contributing factors, focused effort in this area can have the largest impact.

Developing Systems

- Implementing systems for effective communication, teamwork and problem solving.
- Engages employees in recognizing opportunities and problem solving in faster response cycles
- Can be nurtured to keep residents at the center of all decisions, empowering those closet to the residents to make decisions

Problem Solving

- Communication strategies to support problem solving with informed decisions
- Provide easy access to problem solving information that leads to optimized health, operational, and financial outcomes
- Alleviate staffing issues
- Fostering problem solving leads to a supportive team approach and an engaged workforce.





Bundling for Efficacy

- Structured manner of implementing evidenced based approaches collectively and reliably for an outcome Resar et al. (2012)
- Bundles can be applied with systems approaches where two similar items are implemented for a greater outcome

Communication Systems

- Considerations
 - The Who, What, When, and How
 - Formal vs. Informal
 - Determine goal or outcome (root cause, engagement, service recovery, etc.)
 - Define customer (resident, family, colleague, stakeholder, consultant etc.)

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Time-Saving Benefits of Enhanced Communication




- Improved information flow reduces miscommunication and delays.


Implementing Technology Solutions

- Alexander and Madsen (2020) Classify technology solutions into categories of Resident Care, Clinical Support, and Administrative Activities
- Research indicated health leader concern about how technology is implemented and its negative impact on outcomes, work-arounds or sentinel events.
- Health IT Legislation continues to be a focus, most recently 21st Century Cures Act (Cures Act) (ASTP, 2024)

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


Ability to Adapt & Respond

- Track residents' health and wellness in real time, including vital signs, movement, and other key health metrics.
- Streamline how nurses, doctors, and caregivers communicate and support a faster response.
- Simplify the documentation process/reduces the administrative burden on staff.














Implementation Considerations

- Stakeholder involvement is critical to the success of the program
 - Leadership drives and supports implementation
 - Identify process champions
 - Consider training needs, including sandbox feature
 - Engage with residents and families
- Maintain open door policy for issue identification
- Consider support for those individuals resistant to the change
- Measure and celebrate the successful implementation steps





Maximizing Efficiency Through Technology




- Incorporating technology streamlines communication and information sharing.



Maximizing Efficiency with External Resources




- Leverage community networks to access shared resources.




When Prioritizing Daily Tasks

- Identify the highest priority tasks
 - Safety, compliance, workforce support, business operations, family & resident satisfaction
 - Pareto Principle applies in identifying the 20% of the focus driving 80% of the challenges.
- Delegate
- Avoid multi-tasking
- Reduce distractions
- Address lower priority items during quiet periods


