Today, Ms. Barrett's focus is on her non-profit, the Rona Barrett Foundation, and helping to address today's growing crisis in care for our most vulnerable seniors.

On Monday, May 7, Everson Walls, a former NFL player will talk to attendees about "Putting Your Team First." During his career, from 1981-1993, he set many first time records and earned various honors. Mr. Walls played for legendary coaches such as Tom Landry, Bill Belichick, and Bill Parcells. After leaving the League, he has dedicated his time to the foundation he started with Dallas Cowboys' teammate and lifetime friend, Ron Springs. The Ron Springs & Everson Walls Gift for Life Foundation educates people on chronic kidney disease and about the living donor process. In 2007 Mr. Walls donated a kidney to Mr. Springs after he was diagnosed with Type 2 diabetes in 1990.

In addition, a student poster session, leadership panel and social activities will allow networking and peer learning. Attendees will also visit with over 50 of the leading long term care product and service companies dedicated to providing the latest solutions to deliver resident care cost-effectively and efficiently.
